Severe storms can bring heavy rains that lead to flash flooding. Never drive through a flooded area. Remember — turn around, don't drown.

SAFETY DURING SEVERE STORMS

Atlantic hurricane season brings the potential for severe storms through the end of November. Know how to stay safe during and after a severe storm:

- Stay far back from downed power lines. The lines and the ground around it could be charged and dangerous. Notify NOVEC immediately and call 911. Advise others to stay away from the area until qualified personnel arrive on the scene.
- If a power line falls on a vehicle, stay back and notify police. Unless there is immediate danger, like vehicle fire, it is safest for those inside the vehicle to stay put until professional help arrives.
- Never touch any object — like fallen trees, tree limbs, or other debris — that is in contact with power lines.
