PREPARE NOW FOR SUMMER STORMS

Severe storms with heavy rain, lightning, and high winds can cause flooding and power outages. Follow these tips to be ready for summer storms.

- Have an emergency kit prepared with water, nonperishable food, a first-aid kit, and extra batteries. Find a full list of items at [ready.gov/build-a-kit](https://www.ready.gov/build-a-kit).
- Keep cellphones charged and have a full-battery portable charger as backup.
- During an outage, use flashlights or battery-powered lanterns instead of candles to prevent fire hazards.
- Secure outdoor items, such as patio furniture and grills, or bring them indoors if possible so they do not get caught in high winds.
- If you see downed power lines or poles, stay back. The ground around them could be energized and dangerous. Notify NOVEC immediately and call 911.
